Collegiate Mentoring

Collegiate mentors are paired with youth ages 7-18. The pairs meet twice a week for an hour to work on homework and build a positive relationship. Pairs bake, draw, craft, play outside, and take field trips throughout the community & UW campus together.

Afterschool Tutoring (M/T/Th 3-5pm)

Tutors provide one-on-one homework help in an informal setting to students ages 7-17. Tutors should be comfortable helping youth of all ages. Individuals with familiarity in STEM subjects (geometry, chemistry, algebra, etc.) are encouraged to participate!

Art Lab (M 3:00-4:30pm)

Art Lab volunteers lead youth (ages 7-14) in guided art lessons and also provide a space for open art studio time where youth can work on school projects and explore their own art interests.

Teen & Youth Cooking Clubs (TBD)

Cooking club volunteers help the instructor prepare & lead fun and nutritious cooking activities for youth (7-12) and teens (13-18).

Open Gym (F 4-7pm)

Volunteers are needed to supervise Open Gym for youth ages 10-18. Volunteers will join in on recreational activities such as basketball, ping pong, volleyball, etc., and monitor the safety and well-being of participants.

Drop IN & Hang OUT (M 2-4pm, W 3-5pm)

Drop In & Hang Out provides older youth with a safe and comfortable space to spend free time after school. Volunteers will supervise youth in unstructured and structured activities.

Club Friday (F, 1x month, 5:30-8pm)

Club Friday is a one of a kind experience for Madison youth ages 8-14! Volunteers will help with and supervise arts & crafts, games, gym activities and dancing, help with set-up/clean-up and snacks, and make sure the experience runs smoothly.

Thrift Store (Weekdays TBD)

Neighborhood House provides a service to the community through our thrift store. Volunteers interact with customers and run the check-out. Volunteers are also needed to collect, sort, organize, and display items. Great for individuals or groups!

Center Maintenance (F 12-5pm)

A great option for clubs or groups! Volunteers will spend time working on projects around the center that include gardening/landscaping, painting, cleaning, organizing and collecting donations, and center upkeep.

Adult Wellness Classes (Weekdays)

We currently offer Senior Fitness classes, but are looking to expand our fitness class offerings. Volunteers will plan and lead fitness classes.

LOV-Dane Social Nights (2nd Th, 6:30-8:30pm)

Living Our Visions, Inc. (LOV-Dane) is a grassroots organization of individuals with disabilities, their families, friends, and community members building fulfilling and community-centered lives for all citizens.

The group meets monthly and volunteers will help with setup/clean-up and spend time socializing, playing games, eating, and attending outings in the community.

One Time Events

Another great opportunity for groups and individuals. Neighborhood House hosts community events such as festivals or dinners throughout the year. Volunteers help with set-up, clean-up, and the event itself.

Computer Help
